Summer reading statistics: 2012 and 2013 sheets handed out to compare. K thru 6th grade 2013 numbers were down significantly. However, percentage of kids that completed the program remained about the same. Alicia has heard from program speakers that all area libraries are reporting with decreased numbers. Surveys were sent out, one for teens and one online. Some feed back was received. Alicia indicated she will look at the survey results and decide what if anything we want to do differently next year. Very little negative feedback was received. Deb indicated she had a complaint about the ways we do prizes. Specifically, patron's daughter didn't win any prizes despite the large amount read; however, the person could offer no suggestions as to a more "democratic" way to do it. Alicia indicated she is open to suggestions and ideas as long as the ideas stay within the budget. Natalie suggested that the people who didn't win something get their names put in a bucket with an opportunity to win something else.

The Scholastic Book Fair resulted in \$380 in free books.

Library planning lots of activities in September and October. Fall toddler time will restart on September 17, Saturday programs restart with a little Halloween party on October 26. The Teen program starts up in 3 weeks and will host a fall party on November 4. local Author, Amanda Barber from Jackson, MI will be at the library for a meet and greet on September 13. The book club will meet September 23, at both 12 pm and 6 pm.
