The reimbursement papers have been submitted for the technology grant. Saturday programs being changed and upgraded to accommodate older children, utilizing chapter books for a 4-5 week period instead of just books geared toward younger children. Teen group made noise makers and discussed activities for the upcoming year, next group will have a fall party.
