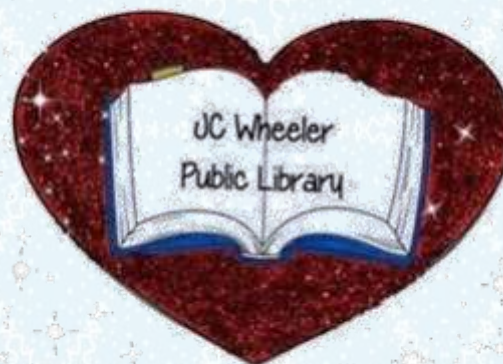

cones, snowflakes, and some silver tinsel to represent snow. Stop in and vote for their tree!

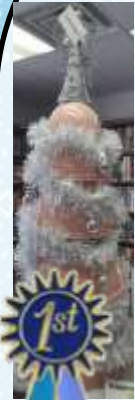
Teen book club met to discuss 'Dreamtreaders' by Wayne Thomas Batson, and will be meeting again in
