Summer Reading Program.

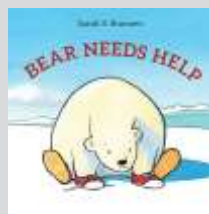
On July 22nd at 1pm we will meet to discuss "Hidden Figures" by Margot Lee Shetterly.



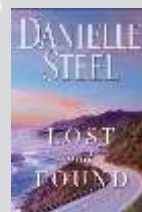
