## Book Sale!!

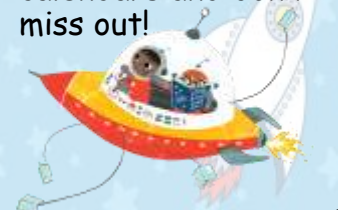
Due to construction at the Township Hall, the Friends of the Library will be having their 'Fall' Book sale in June!

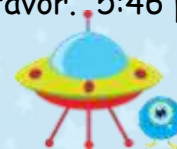

Summer Reading Program.

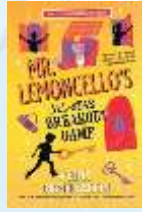
On June 24th at 1pm we will meet to discuss "Good Morning, Midnight" by Lily Brooks-Dalton. This books has received a lot of great reviews and we

have high hopes for it.

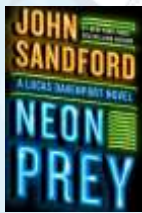
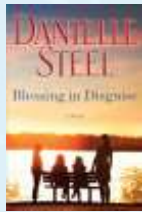
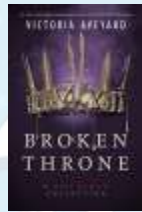
