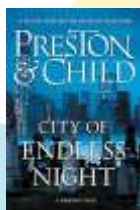
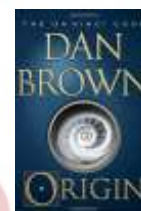
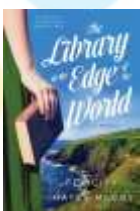
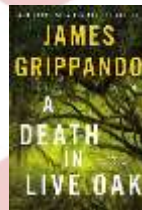
We've had a good year with FUNDRAISING, but feel the affects of it on our aging bodies! In order to continue paying for worthwhile projects & some
